



Short Presentation about the Artistic Project

Tribute 915 015 An itinerant, monumental "installation - performance" which will be presented starting from Milan and then be moved in the major European capitals and throughout the rest of the world.

The installation will be formed by 5 artworks on one side and 20 on the other, for a total dimension of 120 x 500 centimeters and it will be possible to position both vertically and horizontally.

The 100 works come from 100 pages of 100 history books dedicated to the First World War. A story, an anecdote, a short excerpt of life, taken from 100 different books, published in several languages in the last 100 years. These pages, duly supported, are used as a surfaces for the artistic intervention. Above them one shot will release colors and powders that will design a unique artwork created by a bullet and by the genius of an artist. The performance takes place in the spaces where there were consumed the tragedies of war.

Will be drawn an important book published by Giorgio Mondadori in English and Italian by about 300 pages.
